Tuesday Tastings on December 11<sup>th</sup> at L'Thai Restaurant and Wine Bar in Tucker



### **Share the Care for December**

EUWC has a history of loyalty and special interest in the Fulton County CASA. They recruit and train volunteers to advocate for abused and neglected children in foster care. Volunteers undergo extensive training and maintain at least monthly contacts with each child/teen assigned to them in order to make recommendations to the Court in determining permeance in the foster system or reunification with family. In 2017 we donated more than 50 suitcases for distribution. This gesture gave the children a sense of value and made them feel that someone really cared. Remember how excited the staff were at the Christmas brunch last year when that tower of suitcases was given to them? This year we will donate wrapping paper. Of course, we will continue to make monetary donations as well. Imagine that you are responsible for providing all the Christmas gifts for a child or teen. How much would you spend?
