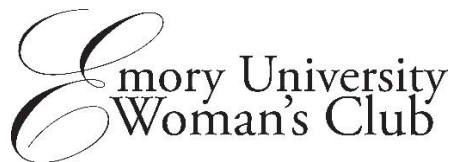
Needs: With this cooler weather they need individual packets of oatmeal, any flavor. Checks may be made to *NETWorks Cooperative Ministries*.

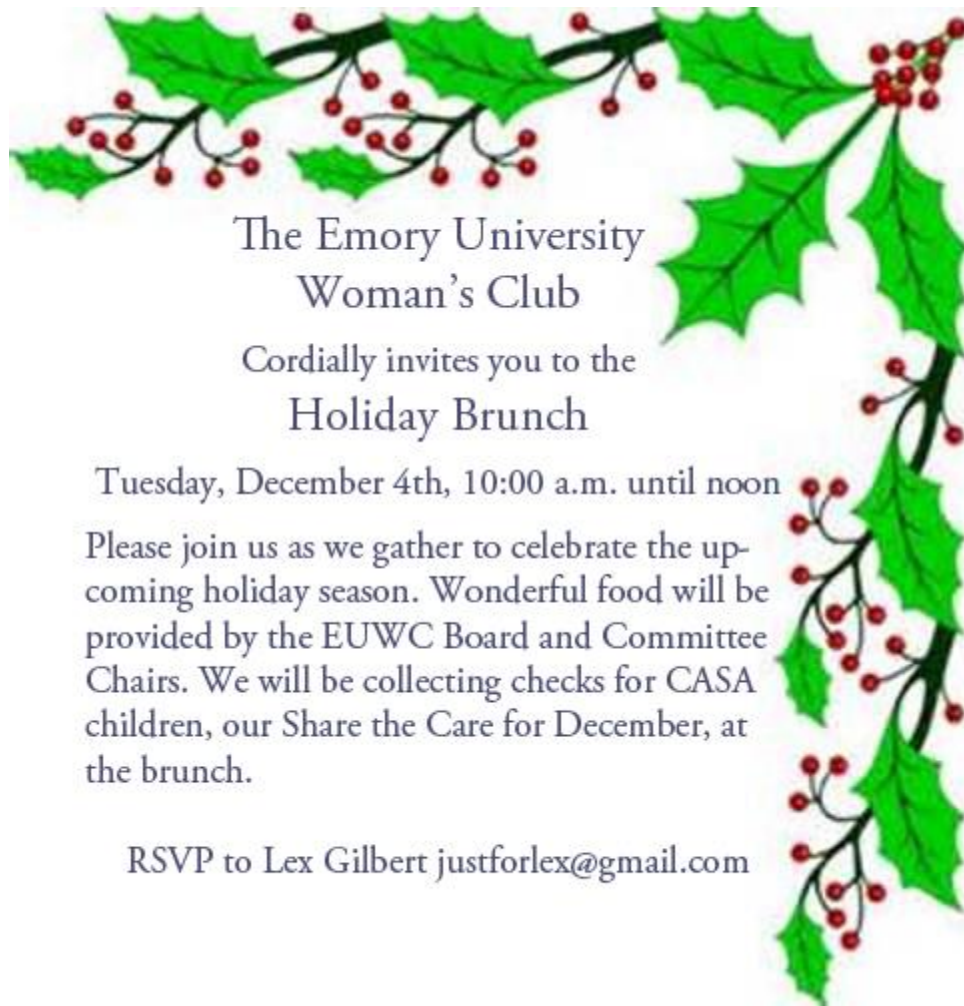
