Community Advanced Practice Nurses, Inc.—
Founded in 1998, Community Advanced Practice Nurses, Inc. (CAPN) is a non-profit organization that provides free primary healthcare and mental/behavioral health services for homeless and medically under-served families, women and children in metropolitan Atlanta. CAPN provides care through clinics that are co-located within homeless shelters. The organization’s mission is to strengthen the ties of people who are medically under-served. Healthy independence is promoted through healthcare delivered with acceptance, compassion, and sensitivity to an individual’s life circumstances. The organizations purposes are to: 1) provide opportunities for patients to learn healthy adaptive life skills; 2) create a climate of supportive healthcare encounters; 3) advocate for the needs and services of the target population; 4) promote collaborative relationships with agencies serving the needs of target population; and 5) foster an environment conducive to learning for healthcare and social service students and professionals.
