We have just been informed that our Graduate Fellowship Award has been presented to Danielle Villa, '19G, '23G.

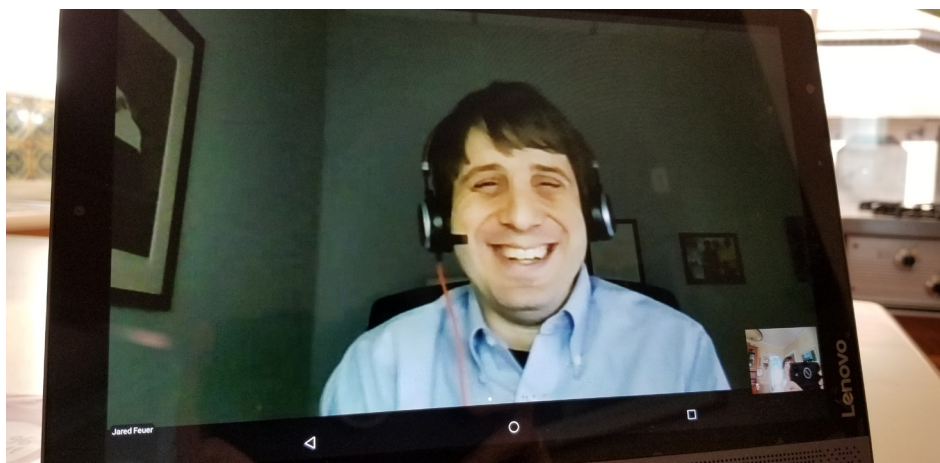
I have written her and hope to have more information about her research and to set a time for her to give us an overview of her work.
