Katie Kelly Bell has been traveling the globe in pursuit of wine, food, and travel stories for over 16 years. From the vineyards of New Zealand to the press houses of Champagne, she has met a world of fascinating people who have stories to share. In between adventures she contributes to several global and national outlets including USA Today, Sherman's Travel, Decanter and Departures. She also co-authored a travel guide (The Everything Guide to Ireland), edited a city guide for Atlanta, and worked as a Senior Editor at The Wine Report. She has made appearances on CNN's Travel Channel as a travel expert and was recently awarded the MAGS Association Magnolia Award for excellence in writing and editing. She resides in Atlanta with her husband David and is mother to three children ages 23, 21 and 17.

Graduate Fellowship Recipient

Danielle Villa is a PhD candidate in the Department of Political Science at Emory University. Her research broadly focuses on conflict management and human security. Danielle's dissertation explores the role of host governments in United Nations peacekeeping operations; she examines how the need for government consent influences peacekeeper subnational deployment and effectiveness, with a regional focus on African civil conflicts.

In addition to peacekeeping operations, Danielle also researches violence against civilians, foreign-imposed regime change, pro-government militias, and more. Starting in the fall of 2020, Danielle will be a predoctoral fellow at The George Washington University's Institute for Security and Conflict Studies.

Danielle is originally from Connecticut, and received her BA from Marist College in Poughkeepsie, NY. Outside of her research, Danielle enjoys running, trying out new recipes, and exploring the national parks.
