MARCH Speaker–Danielle Villa, 19G 23G

We are pleased to have as our speaker this month our Graduate Fellowship Award Winner Danielle Villa! In her statement as our fund beneficiary Danielle describes her research.

“My research is driven by an underlying goal of understanding how to reduce human suffering in conflict. To that end, my dissertation explores the relationship between governments and UN peacekeeping operations. Operations must deploy with the consent of the host government, and consent can be revoked at any point, forcing peacekeeper exit. This gives governments leverage over the mission: by threatening to revoke consent, governments gain power over international actors and can influence peacekeeper action. I argue that, due to that threat, peacekeepers deploy to the locations where they support governments in battle but are less able to halt government violence. I am honored to be the recipient of the Emory University Woman’s Club endowment, which has already greatly impacted my graduate experience. This award covers the entirety of my health insurance costs, and having access to quality health care—especially during a pandemic has allowed me to focus on my dissertation with my full attention and ease of mind. I will be able to successfully complete my dissertation because of the support of the Woman’s Club.”

Snack in a Backpack

Snack in a Backpack will celebrate 10 years of service in April. This outreach ministry provides bags of weekend food to children who are at risk of hunger. During the pandemic, many of the children we serve and their families have significant need for additional food; and Snack in a Backpack has been providing families with multiple bags of food each week. We are currently serving children attending SL Lewis Elementary School, the Global Village Project (a school in Decatur for refugee girls), and the Inspire after school program for middle school children of refugee families in the Clarkston area. These families have over 500 total people in their households, including more than 300 children. A gift of \$25 will buy 25 bags of rice; \$100 will provide assorted fresh produce from the Farmers Market for 25 families; and \$200 will procure over 2500 pounds of food from the Atlanta Community Food Bank. We welcome volunteers to help us on Thursday afternoons to set-up, pack food, and load vehicles for delivery.
