Amani Women Center is the recipient of the Share the Care donations for September. There could not be an organization more worthy of and more in need of our money donations at this time than the Amani Center! This past year among other things, Amani has provided refugees with science based facts about the virus in language they can understand and seen that they are vaccinated. Also the Amani Sewing Center has focused on making thousands of CDC-approved masks for hospitals, organizations, etc. providing help to eradicate Covid 19 and put a little cash in the refugees to put food on their tables. The most important news is Amani has moved from their old rental space into their recently purchased house right in the middle of Clarkston with much needed access to public transportation! At our last EUWC zoom meeting, questions were raised: “Exactly what does Amani need for their new house?” “How are our money donations being spent?” I asked Doris Mukangu (president of Amani and 2016 RSPH recipient of EUWC scholarship) and below was her reply: (Please see photos attached of the new refugee house)

What a journey this had been: from purchasing our new home during a pandemic, to moving out from the old location, to currently trying to fix up the house to be a habitable and safe space to continue our very important work! A lot of work has gone into this and it has truly been a labor of love. We have made great strides but still have quite a ways to go.
