News about Amani Women Center

Historical Note: The founder of Amani Women Center, Doris Mukangu, was our Rollins School of Public Health Scholarship recipient for 2016.

Amani Women Center in offers 3 unique programs utilizing a holistic approach designed to build and sustain healthy families within the home and the community.

- Amani Sewing Academy (AWC) - Workforce Development & Life Skills
- Healthy Families Program (HFP) - Support Services (Civic & Social)
- Leadership Program - (ACALP) - Amani Community Ambassadors.

The Amani Women Center was recently able to move into their new space at 3777 Church Street, Clarkston.

AWC has done a terrific job getting refugees to participate in the virus vaccination program. Over 600 people have been vaccinated for Covid as well as the flu.



The Amani Sewing Academy has established a scholarship program. The donation of \$50 per month for six months will facilitate a woman refugee to flourish in so many ways. The ASA has a waiting list of women desperate to participate, learn a skill well and establish a vehicle for an income. Since many of the women cannot afford the monthly fee, there is an opportunity to help. If you contribute, you will be assigned a student with whom you can become as involved as the two of you would like. In other words, your contribution could be more than fiscal. But if contributing money only is your wish, that is possible as well. You will be invited to the graduation at the end of the program at which each student receives their own brand-new sewing machine and lots of hugs. Please consider helping out this worthwhile group.

The popular boutique will soon be open at the new location. We will provide information as soon as it is available.
