EUWC at Board of Visitors Meeting



Our club was well-represented at Emory's Board of Visitors on April 25. EUWC member Kes Robinson is Director of Corporate Engagement in the Office of Corporate and Foundation Relations so she is hostess for this event. Emory President Greg Fenves was the primary speaker. In attendance were Alma Owens, Judy Michna, Cheryl Murphy, and Teri Hopkin, all of whom were delighted to share the benefits of EUWC membership with other guests.

President Fenves revealed the One Emory: Heart and Ambition plan for the future: a future that includes more generous funding for needy students, fund raising for an increase in endowed department chairs, some big expansion plans that you may have seen in the media lately, and far too many projects to be adequately described here. Last November the 185,000 square foot R. Randall Rollins Building was opened adjacent to two previously built buildings honoring Randall Rollins' mother and grandmother. All are committed to global health solutions. Just this March there was another addition on campus, the eight-story Health Sciences Research Building II located on Haygood Road. Funded largely by the Woodruff family, this facility is dedicated to cutting-edge medical studies. Most recently, a 17-story tower named Winship Cancer Institute at Emory Midtown opened on May 9. It was designed to provide total care for cancer patients at one location.

Sometimes it is gratifying just to step outside and look at what is happening around us.
