

Our private tour will be led by Michael McDavid, a very popular and highly respected OLLI (Emory Lifelong Learning Center) instructor. The current exhibit is *Recasting Antiquity: Whistler, Tanagra, and the Female Form.* An excerpt describing the exhibit from the Carlos Museum website is below.

"Recasting Antiquity: Whistler, Tanagra, and the Female Form focuses on a series of works on paper by the American artist James McNeill Whistler (1834–1903), created in the early 1890s under the inspiration of the recently excavated Hellenistic Greek terracotta figurines known collectively as Tanagras. The first exhibition to explore this theme in Whistler's art, Recasting Antiquity brings some thirty Whistler prints and pastels into conversation with ancient Tanagra figurines on loan from the Louvre Museum and considers what the taste for Tanagras at the turn of the twentieth century reveals about the changing attitude to classical antiquity and conventional Western notions of femininity."
