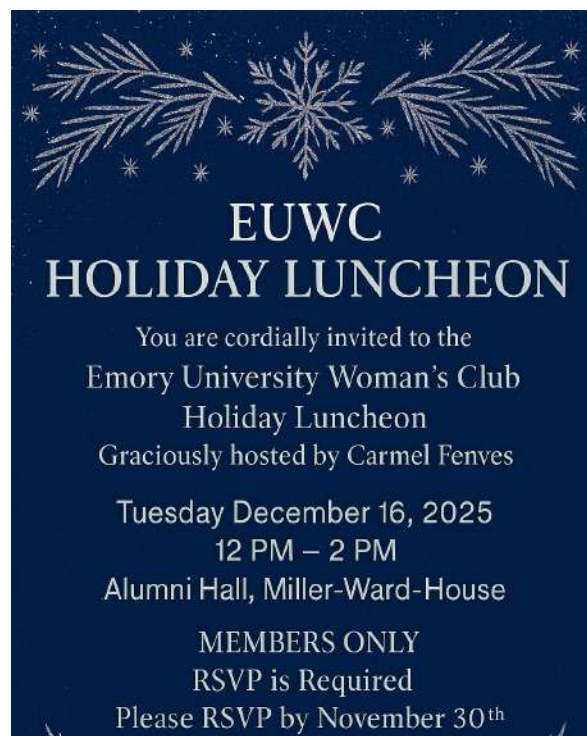
Share the Care
