Cheryl Murphy Selected for Outstanding Alumna Award

Our very own Emory University Woman's Club President, Cheryl Murphy, has been selected to receive one of Emory's most prestigious awards, the Outstanding Alumna Award presented annually by the Emory Alumnae and Women Network and the Emory Alumni Association. The award notification cites her board service, servant leadership, and the Emory legacy she has built.

We are all familiar with Cheryl's exceptional service to the Emory University Woman's Club in which she has been a loyal member for more than thirty years, served multiple terms as president, and held most of the club's other leadership positions, many of them more than once. Many of us also know of her dedication to Emory's School of Nursing, where she graduated in 1977, going on to a professional career working in the Emory Hospital operating room, and to exceptional volunteer service representing the nursing on the Annual Giving Board, serving as president of its Alumni Board, frequently giving the alumni welcome to graduating nursing students at Commencement, and now being part of the school's campaign leadership team.

Cheryl also has been an active participant in the Adopt-A-Scholar program and has served on Emory's Board of Visitors and the Houston Mill House Board of Directors. She and her husband Fred are true citizens of the university community, being members of the Parent Council when their daughter and son were Emory students and being annual patron-level supporters of the Emory Library's Twelfth Night literary celebration.

The award will be presented at the Emory Alumni Awards Celebration ceremony, hosted by the Emory Alumni Association on Thursday, March 18. This alumni awards event will celebrate Cheryl as the recipient of the Outstanding Alumna, along with the recipients of the university's other major alumni awards including the Emory Medal, the J. Pollard Turman Service Award, and the Community Impact Awards.

A Letter From Your President

Regarding Action Taken at the January 26th Membership Meeting

On January 19th, 2021 the Executive Board of the Emory University Woman's Club met via ZOOM platform. This is the customary Board meeting held each year in January to discuss mid-year progress and the status of our committees; 11 members were present.

We heard from our Executive committee reports on the minutes, the state of our budget, membership, newsletter and the yearbook. We have continued to meet this 2020-21 season via zoom with our monthly speakers and have supported Share-the-Care generously. Committee members have maintained contact with their interest groups though in some cases outside groups have suspended activity due to the social distancing policies related to Covid-19.

This is also the time of year for the appointment of a nominating committee to be announced at the January membership meeting. Our EUWC Constitution states Article 4, Section 7 that "a committee of not fewer than five members shall be appointed by the president, confirmed by the Executive Committee and confirmed at the January meeting."

Discussion ensued concerning the extreme state of organizations such as ours that have been unable to meet in person to recruit new members and the fatigue of the current officers. The board was in agreement that to try to change officers for this Fall 2021-22 season would be counter-productive as we continue to navigate unknown territory.

The Constitution states in Article 4, Section 5 that "No members shall hold the same office more than two consecutive years. However, at the request of the nominating committee this requirement may be suspended for one year by a two-thirds vote of a regular quorum." The Executive Board recommended that the current officers remain in their positions for one more year. The current officers agreed to this recommendation.

At the regular January meeting on the 26th of this month the membership was apprised of the recommendation of the Executive Board. As the recommendation arose in Committee it required that a quorum of the general membership (20) by two-thirds of votes approve the recommendation of the Committee. Twenty-seven members in attendance voted in the affirmative to retain the current officers for the 2021-2022 season beginning in the Fall of this year.

This letter is to let everyone know of the action taken. We are confident that when society opens up again that our club will return to customary operations in compliance with our Constitution and By-Laws.
