Our speaker on November 17 is Jared Feuer, COO of Moving Forward, a social change organization which focuses on improving police-community relations. Among Jared's topics will be the unique initiative known as OneCOP developed to facilitate connections between law enforcement and the populations they serve. To accomplish this goal, Moving Forward builds bridges of understanding via initiatives developed by faith-based institutions and law enforcement agencies working together. In October during the National Faith and Blue Weekend, over 650 events were held across the nation.
